SESSION 1: PERSEVERANCE

PERSEVERANCE - vital for following Jesus.

"This calls for patient endurance on the part of the saints who obey God's commandments and remain faithful to Jesus" Rev. 14:12

- Jesus had disciples who fell away. Jn.6:66
- Paul says, don't be "uninformed" about our troubles, suffering" 2Cor. 1:3-11
- The writer of Hebrews, "You need to persevere so that ... you will receive what he has promised." Heb. 10:36

WHY IS PERSEVERANCE NECESSARY?

1. The Reason.

The message of Revelation: A cosmic clash of powers (that produces trials and hardship) but with a promised victorious outcome for the Lamb and his followers.

- How long? (6:10); Who can stand? (6:17)

Jesus and Dragon CH.12

A Clash of Powers:

- Apocalyptic picture (v.1-4)
- Cosmic battle (v.7-9)
- Woman and child protected to confront the powers. (v.13,16-17)
- Believers overcome the power of the dragon. (v.11)

The Contrast of Powers:

Dragon Lamb
Earth Heaven
Babylon Jerusalem
Force Freedom

Coercion Trust

Viciousness Kindness
Self-serving Self-giving

Defeat Victory

2. The Threats.

The warnings of Revelation: "Those I love I warn/rebuke and discipline.." (3:19) Watch out for things like:

- cold love 2:4
- fear 2:10
- false beliefs 2:14-15
- immorality 2:20-22
- spiritual sleepiness 3:1-2
- exhaustion 3:8
- indifference 3:15

What have you learned about perseverance in the last 15 months that can be written into your story? How can you apply it more to your Christian walk?

PART 2: HOW DO WE OVERCOME?

1. The Way.

The Exhortations of Revelation: Those who "do my will to the end.." 2:26

Revival things like:

- a spirit of remembrance 2:5
- paying attention to warnings 2:10
- allowing the Spirit to search mind and heart 2:23
- being careful with deeds 3:2-3
- going ahead and being faithful when feeling weak 3:8
- opening the door to Jesus each day 3:20

2. The Means.

The Victory of Revelation: Jesus' death and resurrection procures our victory. 5:9-10

The Key to Overcoming. 12:11

- 1. The Blood of the Lamb overcomes the power of the dragon The world, flesh and devil.
- 2. The Word of Their Testimony It was all Jesus and what he did. Our testimony is for revival not survival.
- 3.Death to SelfDying with Christ to our own way.
